




#### **Duke of Edinburgh Award (DofE)**

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is a voluntary, non-competitive programme giving our young people the opportunity to experience new activities or develop existing skills. At Framingham Earl, we offer our Year 10 students the chance to complete their Bronze Level Award, completing a programme of activities in four sections; volunteering, physical, skills and expedition. In the last 2 years over 70 students have taken part in the Award.

In Year 9, we run a taster session for the Duke of Edinburgh Award. This taster session takes place in Activities Week and the students have the opportunity to walk, camp, cook and find out if D of E is something they would like to participate in.

Students who take part in the John Muir Award trip to Yorkshire also qualify for Duke of Edinburgh in Year 10.
